Pennant Rules & Conditions

1. **MATCH BALLS** (white 3 Star + plastic balls) and **SCORESHEETS** are supplied each Friday. Please **return completed scoresheet and ball as early as possible** after the match.
2. Matches are played to 11 advantage points. The singles are played first – best-of-5 games. Doubles are played last – best-of-7 for Rounds 1 to 9, and best-of-5 for Round 10 and all finals.
3. **WARM UP** time is available commencing **7:00 PM** for Rounds 1 to 9. Warm up time starts at **6:30 PM** for Round 10 and all Finals. **Note:** A court hire fee is payable to MSAC before this time.
4. **ITTF RACKET** and **CLOTHING** regulations will apply. As match ball is white, players must not wear white shirts or shorts.
5. **WALKOVERS** are not permitted.
6. **FILL IN PLAYERS** - please check the list in the fixture. **It is the responsibility of the player to arrange for a fill-in player** as soon as possible if unable to play him/herself. Players with the bye may fill in, subject to handicap rule below.
7. **HANDICAPS (NEW)** – you may use a fill-in player up to **10 points above** your rating points, but if above your rating points that player will be handicapped by 1 penalty point for every **20** or part thereof by which that player exceeds **your points plus 10**; ie. if rating of fill-in is between **11 to 30** above then **1** handicap point is applied to each game; if rating is **31 to 50** above then **2** handicap points; if rating is **51 to 70** above then **3** handicap points (maximum). This also applies to doubles. If unsure if a player can fill in please check with the Pennant Committee. If the fill in player is on a handicap then the opposing team has choice of serve in the first game of each rubber against the fill in player.
8. **FINALS** – to be eligible to play in finals a player must have played at least **5 rounds** in that season as a team member **or** as a fill in player in that section, **and** be on the same or lower win/loss ratio, **or** a player from a lower section. If no player is available in your section the Pennant Committee may consider a suitable alternative.
9. **FINALS FILL-INS** - There cannot be 2 fill-in players in a finals team. If neither member of a semi-finalist team is available, then the next placed team becomes the 4th-placed team and teams above adjusted accordingly.
10. **TABLE NUMBERS** are allocated each week on a rotational basis. Please check your table number posted on the notice board.
11. **REGISTRATION** – **all players must be registered** either through TTV or another affiliated club or association. TTV RULE – a player can play 3 matches only as a fill in for the year without being registered. This applies only to players not playing in an affiliated club, association, pennant or tournament.
12. **ITTF SERVICE RULE** - from the start of service until it is struck, the ball shall be above the level of the playing surface and behind the server's end line **and it shall not be hidden** from the receiver by the server or his doubles partner and by anything they wear or carry. As soon as the ball has been projected, the server's free arm shall be removed from the space between the ball and the net. It is the responsibility of the player to serve so that the umpire can see that he/she complies with the requirements for a correct service.
13. If, at the completion of the final round, 2 sides finish equal, then a count back of games won over games lost will be undertaken. If still equal then a count back on points won over points lost will be undertaken.

- **Note:** Players with the bye may be used as fill-ins.
- **On the score sheet** – A fill-in must cross out the team member's name who is being replaced, then write the fill-in's name and the number of penalty points (if any).
